It will cost about \$200. There are several other projects they would like to do, but it depends on the funds. They also asked if they could start paying Tina \$100 annually to maintain the city website. It was voted on and approved. They also need volunteers to work these events. Please talk to your groups about volunteering.

Terry motioned that the district give \$200 to the WIS to help pay for the upgrade of the website. Cheryl seconded it and it was approved by all.
